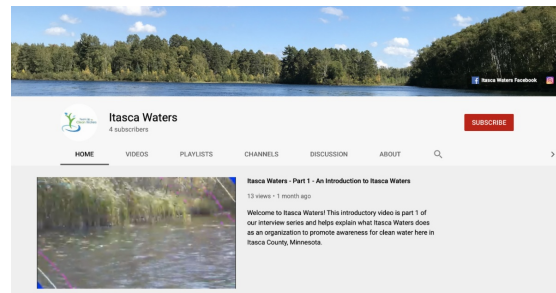
### Lawns and Lakes, There is a Connection
